ICCAs & Aichi Targets

The Contribution of Indigenous Peoples' and Local Community Conserved Territories and Areas to the Strategic Plan for Biodiversity 2011-20 (Aichi Targets)

The Strategic Plan for Biodiversity 2011-20, framed by Parties to the CBD at the 10th Conference of Parties in 2010, outlines an ambitious roadmap towards halting and reversing biodiversity loss across the planet. While clearly not a replacement for the Convention, which is a mix of policy, goals, strategies, actions, and guidance, the Strategic Plan is crucial for its implementation. The 20 'Aichi Targets' it encompasses understandably go beyond ecological and biological aspects, essential as they are, to also focus on the social-cultural, economic, and political elements of achieving this roadmap.

While all sectors of society have a role to play in the implementation of the Strategic Plan, indigenous peoples and local communities are central to it. This is not only because the lands and waters over which such peoples and communities have custodianship and/or customary







- Work towards national governance evaluation & action processes for systems of protected and conserved areas in the Philippines, Iran, Ecuador (2 workshops) ... steady slow progress ...
- Encouragement, support and strengthening of national ICCA Networks (e.g., coalitions, federations and working groups) in Bolivia, Chile, China, Democratic Republic of Congo, Guatemala, India, Indonesia, Iran, Kenya, Madagascar, Nepal, Philippines, Senegal, Spain, Taiwan and Vietnam...
- Studies of the socio-cultural and political-historical context of ICCAs in Xinjiang (China) and the Amazon and Mesoamerica (in progress) + videos on Chile, DRC, etc.



issues for TAG discussion

(results of first Ecuador event & lessons learned in 2015):


- Priority countries could & should be coherently grouped by region to facilitate capacity building and functioning of Regional Learning Networks
- Regional events currently require additional fundraising & involve long UNOPS procedures-- we're dealing with this, but it was not expected
- Workpackage 2 ought to be delivering now its results for packages 1 and 3... It is urgent to get it going!
- ToRs for proactive ICCA initiative— great that they are now agreed; they are to be carefully shared with countries that are “ready” for them...
- Even when received, however, some GEF SGP offices are “sitting on the ToRs” as they still lack info on funding






- In what way is the Consortium expected to support and advise GEF SGP coordinators?
- National workshops and field visits to countries are very useful– how can we institutionalize/ multiply them?
- National validation and support to ICCAs for the Registry opened up discussions (e.g., on the relation between the Registry and WDPA) that are still on-going; desirable processes appear context-dependent
- On the basis of work carried out in 2015, a revised version of the ICCA Resilience and Security Tool will be prepared for the start of GEF SGP GSI grants
- Further work (and publications) on governance vitality are needed & should be planned (with IUCN? As part of Green List analyses?)
- Expressed need for a variety of graphic descriptions of GSI's structure and processes


Project Organisation Structure




ICCA GSI project organisation structure
