This workshop, organised in the framework of the ICCA-GSI initiative, will take advantage of the presence in Switzerland of several African Members and partners of the ICCA Consortium convened for the XIth General Assembly. It will provide an occasion to discuss **cases of emblematic ICCAs** and offer **perspectives on the ICCA situation in various African countries** in the light of **recent successes and setbacks**, and in view of the outcome of the **Sydney World Parks Congress** and **related CBD decisions**. The workshop will allow participants to develop a broad agreement on **crucial steps for the full and effective recognition and support to ICCAs in Africa**, starting from **concrete actions in 2018** but also seeking a longer-term perspective.
