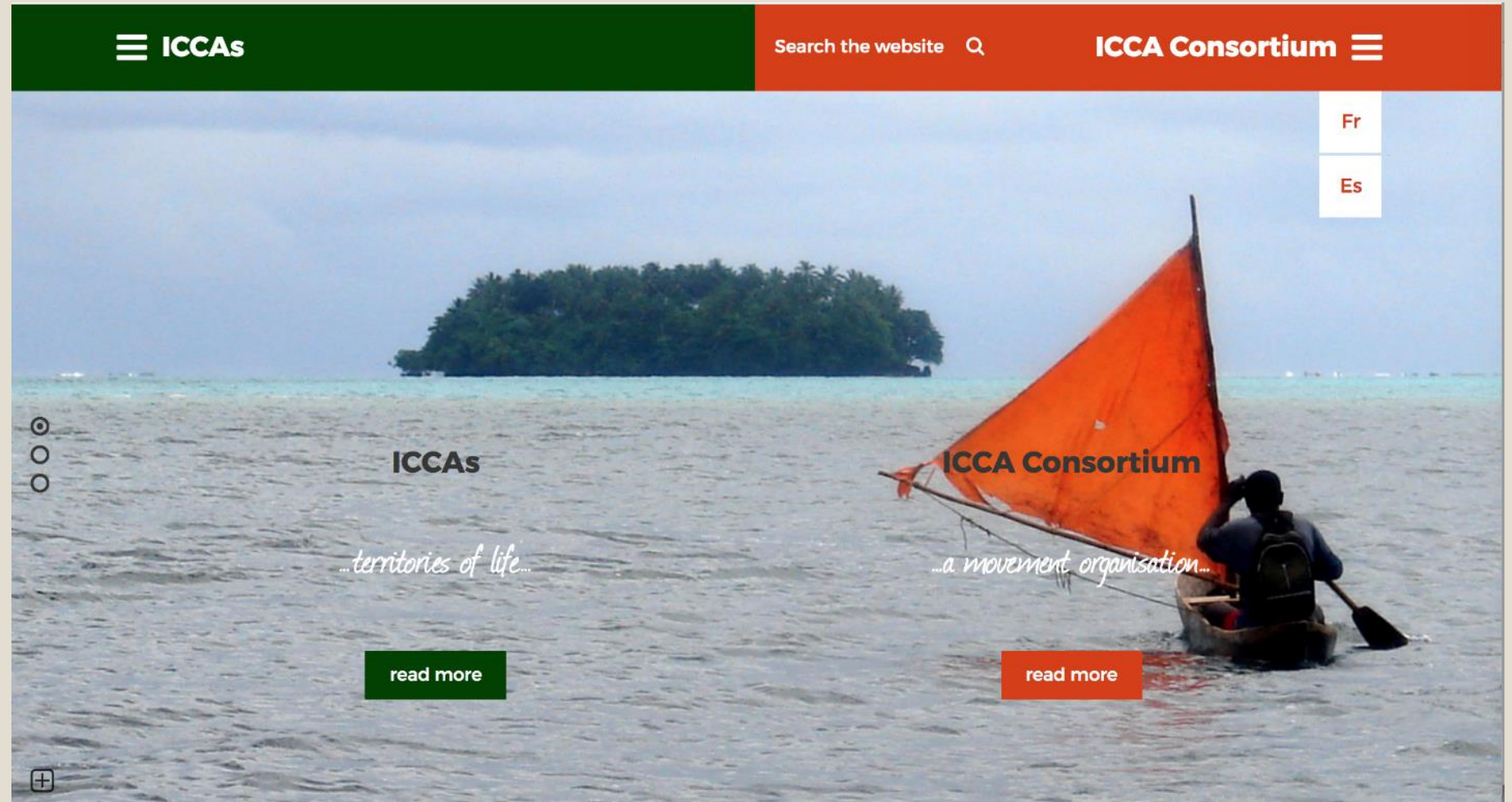

- *Who is collecting the data?*
- *What data is being collected?*
- *What is the legal basis for processing the data?*
- *Will the data be shared with any third parties?*
- *How will the information be used?*
- *How long will the data be stored for?*
- *What rights does the data subject have?*
- *How can the data subject raise a complaint?*

In this way we would like to draw your attention to [legislation about Data Protection that came into force in May 2018](#). We view this legislation as a positive step which aligns with our own values on information sharing and informed consent.

The policy below is a requirement under European Law and we are required to invite you to read it when you use our online services (website, mailing-list, discussion groups, etc).

1 Purpose of policy

We are committed to protecting your personal information and being transparent about what information we hold about you.
